



General Requirements for Academic, Citizenship, and Leadership Letters

1. Award of these letters will be made by a committee of teachers appointed by the principal.
2. Students must make applications and submit certifications for the awards. They must meet all of the deadlines.
3. The school reserves the right to revoke an award if it is found that it was given under false pretenses.
4. Students accused or convicted of juvenile or criminal offenses will not be qualified for these awards and may have previously earned awards revoked.
5. Please note that the letter is an opposite color so that it will not be confused with other school letters.
6. Persons who letter in other areas may wear this letter on the arm near the shoulder of their letter jacket. Any additional devices (bars or pins) may be worn on the main letter.
7. Award of letters will be restricted to grades 9-12 only.
8. The objectives of this program are to:
 - a. Provide a method whereby students who excel in areas other than athletics may earn a school letter.
 - b. Recognize those students who adhere to the rules of the school and work hard to make the school and the community better.
 - c. Provide a means to motivate students who start out their high school career poorly to achieve recognition for improvement.
